

Weekend Schedule:

Registration – Saturday 11th 12noon-5pm

Members of British Triathlon must show a current licence or pay an extra £5 for a Day Licence. Non members will have already paid for a Day Licence which can be downloaded from our website from around 10-14 days before the race, another form of Photo ID will be required.

You'll be given a pack containing race numbers, ankle strap & timing chip, bike sticker, swim hat.

Race Briefings – Sat 11th choose either 2pm or 4pm (attendance compulsory)

Will give you full details of the race to ensure you have the best day possible!

Car Parking – Sunday 12th open from 4.30am

Free parking onsite for competitors & spectators – just follow signs & marshals on arrival.

Bike Racking – Transition open Sunday 12th from 4.30am

Swashbuckler Middle Start: 6am

Finishers: 10.30am - 2pm approx

At the finish we'll collect your ankle timing chip (lost or unreturned ones are charged for at £25 each) & give you your race medal!!

Massage: Available post-race in the marquee.

Prizegiving: 12pm in the marquee / finishline
